## **GRANDVIEW HUNT CLUB RULES AND REGULATIONS**

Grandview is a Trophy Managed hunt club and strives for safe and enjoyable hunting experience for all members. These rules, while not inclusive, are in place to guide all members in their day to day hunting activities. Anyone hunting at Grandview is expected to follow these rules. Any questions please see the management.

### **CLUB DUES**

1. A club membership will run from 1 September of the current year through 31 August the following year. Club dues will be paid in full by 1 September. There will be no hunting until your dues are paid in full.

### **BUCK SIZE**

1. Grandview is a Trophy Managed Club. Any buck harvested must have a minimum outside antler spread of 15 inches and will be strictly enforced. This applies to all members and their youth or guest hunters. The penalty for harvesting a buck smaller than the minimum is \$200.00. Penalties will go into effect starting in the 2010-2011 hunting season.

2. All members should strive to harvest only mature deer. Any button buck harvested by a member or their youth or guest hunters will have a penalty of \$100.00 to be paid by the member. Penalties will be go into effect starting in the 2010-2011 hunting season.

3. Any member having recurring harvest infractions will not be renewed.

### **GUEST POLICY**

1. To ensure that members have the hunting priority there will be no guests on the following opening weekends.

#### **Early Muzzleloader Season, Modern Gun opener, Spring Turkey opener.**

2. During the above openers a member's dependant youth hunter (defined as not yet 16) may hunt with the member while following state hunting regulation's that require the youth and member to hunt together therefore only taking up one spot.

3. Guest passes for deer or turkey hunts will be available for \$25 each day plus one work credit for any member that has 2 or more work credits. (Does not apply to dependent youth hunters, these are not defined as guests).

4. Guest hunters will be placed in a stand by the sponsor member and do not have location preference over any member who wants that area.

### SIGN-IN AND DATA SITE

1. Record keeping is mandatory. Work days and harvests are to be recorded. Any harvest is to include a picture of the animal.
2. Using the Grandview website in a convenient way to reserve your hunting location preference and will be allowed 48 hours prior to your hunt however you must still stop by the camp and update the club sign-in board/map. The camp sign-in board is real time and allows members to update changes to their hunting location due to wind changes etc. Additionally and most importantly it allows each member to deconflict their hunting location to ensure a safe hunt. At the end of your hunt you must sign out at the map and the website.

### DEER STAND'S

1. Members may erect permanent box blinds with the manager's permission, but they will be property of the club and will not be private. It is understood that the member that constructed the blind would have the priority to hunt from that stand however any member may hunt that stand if unoccupied.
2. Members will be allowed unlimited numbers of portable stands, but they will not lock out other members from hunting near those areas. Stands should not be placed within 100 yards of another stand. If it happens, the last stand set needs to be removed. Stands hung near another revert to "first in" that area gets the spot on a given day. All stands must be marked with the owners name on it. Any stands not marked will be removed and taken to the manager. Any stand not occupied 1/2 hour before legal shooting time is available for use to any member.
3. Stands should be active or removed so as to free up areas for active members. Any abandoned stands from inactive members become property of the club but can be used by anyone unless the condition is not safe, in which case it needs to be removed. If you find an unidentified stand, notify the manager for inspection.

### WORK DAYS and WORKDAY CREDITS

1. Each member must attend a minimum of 2 work days during the year. Each day will earn 1 credit. It is understood that due to work or family commitments some members may not be able to attend a scheduled workday however you may complete a workday on your own schedule. If that doesn't work for you work credits can be purchased instead of earned for \$50 per credit
2. Work day credits or purchased credits can be redeemed for guest passes or for a maximum discount of \$100 on your yearly dues.

### SHOOTING RANGE

1. The only designated shooting area will be in the field directly below the old camping area. Over the next year we will install earthen berm's at 100, 200, 300 and possibly 400 yards. The range will be the only designated area for the sighting in of rifles/weapons and should not

interfere with anyone hunting. Sighting of rifles should be completed in the off seasons however if a weapon needs checked a few rounds is ok. The range will be close from 1 Nov thru the end of late muzzle loader season.

### FOOD PLOTS

1. Several workdays a year will be designated for food plot maintenance and development. It is the goal of Grandview hunt club to provide as many food plots as possible for members to hunt within budget. Members may at there own expense maintain a food plot but that food plot will be the property of the Grandview Hunt Club and open to any member to hunt. It is understood that the member that maintained such a food plot would have the hunting priority, however any member may hunt it.

### GENERAL

1. Hunting at Grandview is a privilege afforded to us by the landowner and should be treated as such. All members and their guests are expected to treat the property as if it were their own. Keeping it clean and neat at all times is required. Anyone using the camp are required to clean up after themselves. While hunting or scouting bring back and dispose of any trash found.

2. The farmer's crop fields are off limits to personal vehicles year round...no exceptions. ATV's are limited to the extreme edge and only for retrieving deer, placing stands or filling feeders etc. Otherwise walk the field.

3. There will no consumption of alcohol while hunting or when shooting on the range.

4. Grandview is a hunting club not an ATV riding club. ATV's are to be used for hunting activities or working only.

5. It is important to keep gates locked at all times. If in doubt lock it. Now that the camp is on the other side of the farm we do not have visibility on the majority of the property.

6. All funds collected for penalties and guest fees will be used for habitat or club improvements.

7. There will be no quail hunting without permission from the manager.

8. Anyone found in violation of State law or club rules will be placed on suspension for a period of time to be determined by the management

9. No shooting or horseplay in the camp area.

10. Every effort should be made to resolve any issues that arise between members by only those members. If they can not be resolved between the two involved, both members should report the issue to the management.
